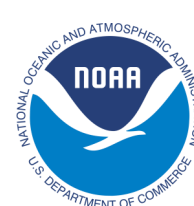
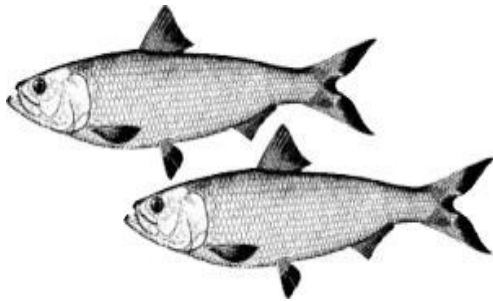

➔ **WHAT:** Learn how to monitor herring migration through the Centennial Island fish ladder, including: counting fish at the ladder, collecting temperature data, and monitoring video footage



➔ **WHY:** Alewife (herring) populations declined with the building of dams on our rivers. Now they're coming back in the highest numbers we've seen in over twenty years! The more data we collect, the more we can advocate to protect this crucial river habitat.
